REPLACE THE WHEEL COVER. BE SURE TO REMOVE THE WOOD!

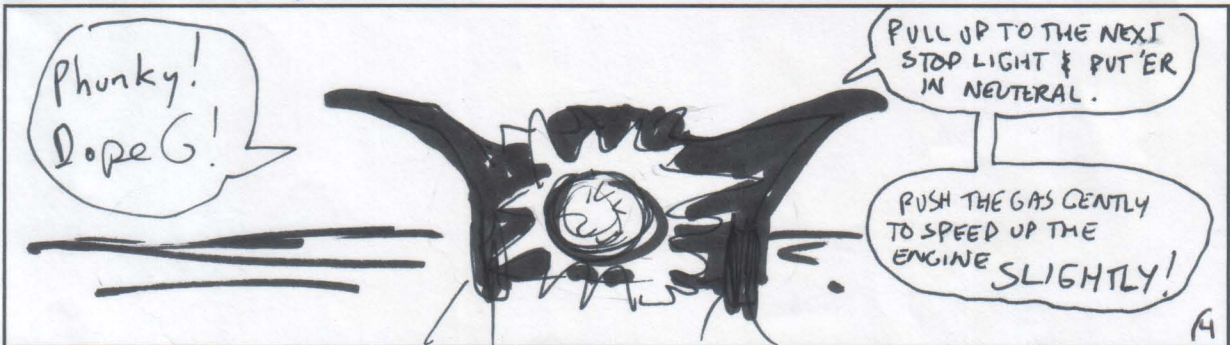
